

FISHING REGULATIONS

PAPEŽ POND

Fishing regulations for the Water Area Papež

Validity: from 1 April 2021

General conditions

These provisions are valid for the Papež Water Area in the Dobříš Cadastral Area. Members of the fishing supervision, who can prove themselves with the fishing supervision card, as well as the Police of the Czech Republic (and lastly the "inspection body"), are entitled to inspect these rules. In the event of a breach of these rules or unauthorized fishing, the control body is entitled to terminate the fisher's daily fishing, or to detain fishing gear, the right to fish, the catch, or transfer the matter to the Police of the Czech Republic or administrative authority. By purchasing a fishing permit, the holder agrees to comply with all such provisions, conditions, and obligations under the fishing regulations of Colloredo-Mannsfeld Co. s r.o. The operator reserves the right to close the complex as a whole for private purposes.

Fishing season of fish

The fishing season on the Papež Pond is from 1 April 2021 to 30 November 2021.

Time of closed season for individual fish species:

From 1 January to 15 June, the following species are protected: asp, zander, wels catfish, pike

Daily fishing time

Behavior during fishing and fisher's duties

While fishing, it is necessary for fishers to keep a minimum distance between themselves, namely 3 m, spinning at least 20 m, unless they agree on a smaller distance. Fishing spots must not be reserved and modified in any way. When angling, the fisher must be present at the rods so he can manipulate them if necessary. If the fisher is fishing in low visibility (at night), he is obliged to illuminate the place with white non-glare artificial light. Making an open fire is not allowed. Cooker and above-ground grill is allowed. The fishers are obliged to keep the fishing spot clean and immediately clean up any of their rubbish.

Method of fishing and fishing equipment

While fishing, it is prohibited to use more than two rods at the same time. Each rod can be at most with two simple hooks. The installation of a "sipper" is strictly forbidden. The obligatory equipment of every fisher is a pad under the fish, a landing net with a shoulder length of at least 70 cm, and disinfection to treat the injuries of fish (punctures by a hook and other injuries). Fishing predatory fish is allowed only by spinning, from 16 June to 30 November.

It is prohibited in the district to:

Use explosive, toxic, or narcotic substances. Fish with the use of electric current, shoot fish, catch fish under the ice, catch fish in lines, in hand, in mesh, catch fish using nets and sacks, chop fish, use spikes, traps, fishing hooks without fishing rods. Use the blood of all protected animals incl. all stages of development as bait. Bait fish with meat, meat mixtures, and dairy sludge. Build any shelters, even with a base (except for the so-called bivouacs). Use boats for fishing, transport baits by boat, feed fish (except for loading boats). Start a fire in the area of the district. Use a lure.

If the fishers have a bivouac built for more than 24 hours, they are obliged to have a basket or a garbage bag.

Obligations of the fisher during the inspection

At the request of the inspection body, the fishers must prove themselves with a valid fishing permit and at the same time with an identity card. The fishers are obliged to carry these documents with them. At the request of the inspection body, the fisher is obliged to show the contents of his fishing backpack or other luggage. Furthermore, the inspection body is entitled to inspect the baits, lures, and fishing methods used. Fishers are also obliged to return their fishing permit in case of violation of the fishing terms.

Final provisions

Each permit holder is obliged to return it to a place where it was issued, immediately after it has expired. Persons authorized to fish based on this permit are obliged to provide support and assistance to the inspection body.
